

## Special Information for Atterbury JMTC Holiday Hunt

1. You must check in at the Atterbury FWA check station by 5 AM EST on the day of your hunt.
2. Each selected hunter may bring one hunting partner.
3. All hunters must present a photo ID and a hunter education card to the check station attendant to check in.
4. You must wear at least (2) pieces of hunter orange clothing.
5. You must possess a military/refuge firearms, military/refuge muzzleloader, military/refuge archery, archery, or extra archery deer license, or the apprentice version of any of these five licenses, depending on the equipment you intend to use. Lifetime hunting, lifetime comprehensive hunting and fishing licenses and youth consolidated hunting and fishing licenses are also valid for this hunt.
6. You may use only a shotgun, muzzleloading gun, or a bow and arrows on this hunt. Centerfire rifles and handguns are not allowed.
7. The daily bag limit on Atterbury JMTC is one deer of either sex.
8. All hunters must be checked out through the Atterbury FWA check station by 4 PM EST.
9. Disabled hunters needing special accommodations must call the Atterbury FWA office prior to their hunt date to request information and assistance.
10. Hunter using elevated stands must wear a safety harness while climbing to and from, and while using the stand.
