



Flood Control Act Permit Renewal Requirement Guide

Amendments to Indiana Code 14-28-1-22 in 2014 and 2015



The amendments made to Indiana Code 14-28-1-22 in 2014 and 2015 on the permit renewal provisions states:

(g) A permit issued under this section:

(1) is valid for two (2) years after the issuance of the permit; and

(2) to:

(A) the Indiana department of transportation or a county highway department if there is any federal funding for the project, or

(B) an electric utility for the construction of a power generating facility;

is valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance.

A permit that is active and was issued under subdivision (1) before July 1, 2014, is valid for two (2) years beginning July 1 2014, and a permit that is active and was issued under subdivision (2) before July 1, 2014, is valid for five (5) years beginning July 2014.

(h) A permit issued under:

(1) subsection (g)(1) may be renewed one (1) time for a period not to exceed two (2) additional years; and

(2) subsection (g)(2) may be renewed one (1) time for a period not to exceed five (5) additional years.

A request for a renewal shall include:

- 1) The permit number of the original permit (FW-XXXXX).
- 2) A statement verifying that the original permittee and their mailing address is unchanged or if the permittee is changed, the name and mailing address of the new permittee and a copy of a deed, lease, contract, etc. demonstrating that the new permittee has acquired an interest in the permit.
- 3) A statement that the plans which were the basis for the original permit and any subsequent amendments are not being changed. (NOTE – Any change to the approved plans will require that a new application.)

A request should be received at the Division of Water at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the original permit.
