Title: Exclusions from Coverage

Purposes: To eliminate confusion concerning what is and what is not provided by CSHCS by identifying those items, which will not be reimbursed by CSHCS.

Rule References:

410 IAC 3.2-7-2(h) – The CSHCN program shall not pay for over-the-counter drugs, medications, or supplies. ...

Policy: While CSHCS may cover services, which may not be obtained through other private, local, state or federal health care programs, the following items and/or services will not be reimbursed by CSHCS. Exceptions to this Policy require approval by the Best Practices Committee, the Medical Consultant (physician) or the Program Director.

The following list is not all-inclusive and will change over time.

DRUGS

Acetaminophen

Aspirin

Anorexia and/or weight loss drugs

Birth control measures (pills/patches/devices/injections)

Drugs with no NDC (National Drug Code)

Drugs to treat sexual dysfunction

Over-the-counter creams, ointments or powders

Over-the-counter (non-legend) drugs, except Insulin

Over-the-counter stool softeners, glycerin, suppositories, laxatives

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EQUIPMENT

Duplicate equipment of all kinds
Air conditioners
Auditory trainers
Bath chairs are excluded for children who weigh less than 40 pounds.
Batteries, generally **in excess of** one disposal battery, per device, per week (although rechargeable wheelchair batteries are allowed)
Bed, any type including Mattresses (Rare exceptions considered by Medical Review Committee)
Bedpan
Blood pressure cuffs (See DME Policy)
Breast pumps
Canes, **except** after orthopedic surgery related to an eligible medical condition, **or when** there is a permanent disability related to an eligible medical condition
Clean air machines, all types

Crutches; crutch tips, **except** after orthopedic surgery related to an eligible medical condition, **or when** there is a permanent disability related to an eligible medical condition

Insulin pump protective case
Lifts for automobiles, vans

PT/OT home equipment
Positioning seats (unless a transportation device)

- intentional overdose of any drug;
- voluntary participation in any unlawful activity, including but not limited to alcohol consumption, illegal drug or narcotic intoxication

Cosmetic/plastic/reconstructive surgery, except as related to an eligible condition and medically necessary

Custodial care

Educational or instructional services (except where necessary for participant to learn about an eligible diagnosis and then must be authorized)

Experimental products, services or technology

Gene therapy

Hospice care

Organ transplantation and/or organ donation

Prenatal, delivery or postpartum care

Private duty nursing care

Psychiatric treatment; mental health services

Repair or replacement of malfunctioning equipment under warranty
