

- 1. Certified as a Comprehensive Outpatient Rehabilitation Facility (CORF) visit <u>Comprehensive</u> <u>Outpatient Rehabilitation Facility (CORF) Certification Program.</u>
- 2. Licensed and certified as an Outpatient Rehabilitation Facility of a Hospital go to visit <u>Hospital</u> (general_Licensing and Certification Program.
- 3. Certified as a Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), performing outpatient therapy in SNF certified areas and therapy is performed by SNF staff or staff contracted by the SNF for therapy under Part B visit Long Term Care/Nursing Homes.
- 4. Licensed and Certified as a Home Health Agency, performing outpatient therapy under Part B visit <u>Home Health Agency (HHA) Licensing and Certification Program</u>.
- Enrolled in Medicare as an Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, or Speech Language Pathologist in private practice.
