Reportable Condition Reporting Guidance



Condition Name:

Hepatitis, viral, Type C pregnant woman (acute and chronic) or perinatally exposed infant

Condition Name in NBS:

For pregnant woman:

- Hepatitis C, acute
- Hepatitis C Virus infection, past or present

For perinatally exposed infant:

• Hepatitis C Viral Infection, Perinatal

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Rapid Hepatitis C test results report with <u>this</u> form
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form via Fax to 317-233-7663

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive Anti-HCV (including rapid tests)
- Nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT, such as PCR) for hepatitis C virus RNA
- HCV Genotype test

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical Epidemiological, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms, including jaundice

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medicals records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history
