- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Pandrug-resistant Organisms
- Any isolates that shows intermediate or resistant to all antimicrobials tested

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiological, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Culture and antimicrobial susceptibility results
- History and physical, admission and discharge notes, and any Infectious Disease doctor's notes
