Condition Name:

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report as an Investigation in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) result

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Latent TB Infection should be reported directly via Investigation rather than Morbidity Report in NBS
- Complete all relevant fields within investigation

Additional Documentation to Include

- Completed Report of Latent Tuberculosis Infection (State Form 49894)
- AFB results (Smear, NAAT, Culture), if done
- Radiography
- IGRA and/or TST
- Treatment information, including DOT records
