Stigmatizing Language

- Increased effort to ensure our program and our materials are using up-to-date, non-stigmatizing language
- Ongoing effort expect to see more changes coming
- Biggest change is our name!
 - No longer TB Control Program....





TB Prevention and Care Program



Rifampin Shortage

- Continue to experience shortages of Rifampin at the national level
 - Across multiple suppliers, multiple issues
- Acquired additional stock from CDC to ensure adequate supplies for refills
- Current Indiana guidance:
 - LTBI Utilize 3HP or other non-Rifampin regimen
 - TB disease Begin new patients on Rifabutin in place of Rifampin
- IDOH and Purdue will continue to monitor the situation



Upcoming Changes to Reporting

- The Indiana Communicable Disease rule will be updated in Summer of 2022
- TB disease (cases and suspects) and LTBI will remain reportable
- Reporting timeframe will now be within one business day (both conditions)
- Changes to control measures & online reporting options in process



RVCT Updates

- CDC released an updated Report of Verified Case of TB Form in 2020
 - Known as TB Investigation in NBS
- Currently working with NBS vendor to update NBS to align with new form
 - TBD date of rollout

New TB/TST In-TRAIN Course

- TB Basics and TB Tests Used to Identify TB Infection course updated in November 2021
 - New course number: 5338
- Course used by IDOH and American Lung Association
 - Prerequisite for the free TST skill validation sessions led by our IDOH TB Regional Nurse Consultants (RNCs) for Indiana local health department public health nurses
 - Perquisite for ALA's TB validation course

 - Resources for Health Care Providers TB and LTBI

CDC LTBI Campaign

- In March 2022, CDC launched a campaign to raise awareness of LTBI called *Think, Test, Treat TB*.
- The campaign aims to raise awareness about LTBI, risk, and the link between LTBI and TB disease.
- Free resources are available in multiple languages, including TB messages, digital and print resources, patient and provider education materials, and a partner toolkit.

Incentive/Enabler Funding Availability

- Funding is available through Hoosier Uplands for incentives/enablers for LHD use
- Example items include rent/hotels, grocery gift cards, phone minutes, clothing/household needs, transportation costs, toys for children, limited clinical costs
- Payment is through reimbursement only
 - Must complete Hoosier Uplands form & W-9 and fax to IDOH for approval


