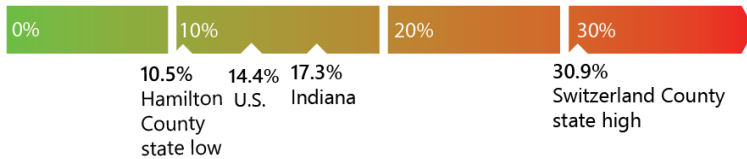

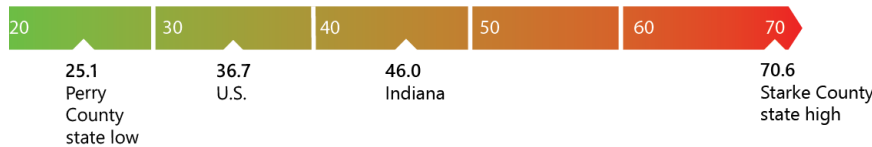
Percent of adults who smoke

**29.1%**



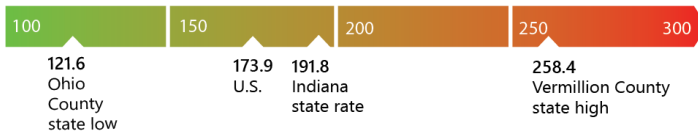
Lung cancer deaths

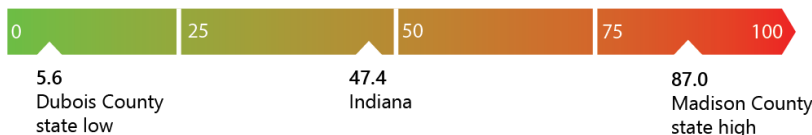
Heart disease deaths
