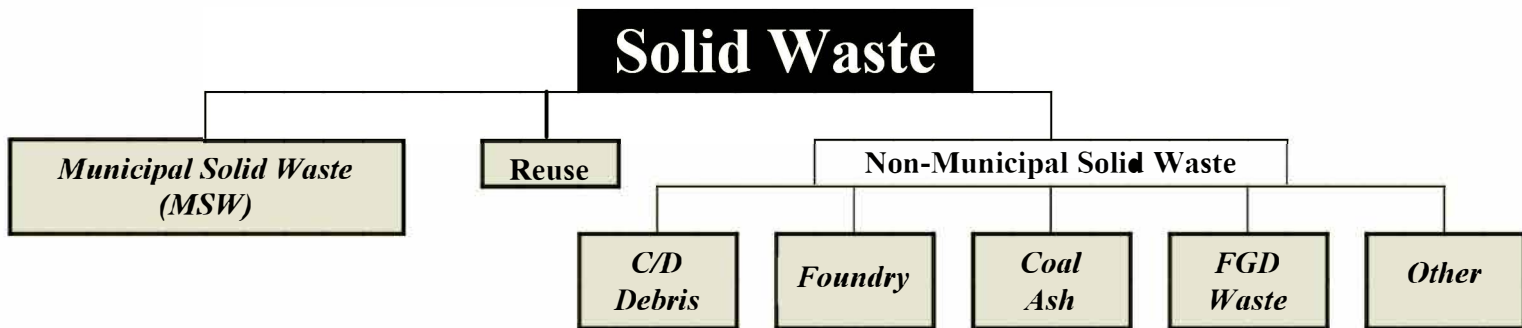


# Waste Classification Guide

## For Solid Waste Facility Quarterly Reports



WASTE TYPE	CATEGORIES INCLUDED	EXAMPLES
<b>Municipal (MSW)</b>	<b>Residential</b> - Single- and multi-family units - Other (campgrounds, parks, etc.) <b>Commercial</b> - Retail and wholesale - Service industry <b>Institutional</b> - Prisons, hospitals, schools, and universities - Government sector <b>Industrial non-process</b> - Offices, lunchrooms, restrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Consumer goods</li> <li>- Packaging wastes</li> <li>- Meals/lunchroom wastes</li> <li>- Office wastes</li> <li>- Yard trimmings / vegetation</li> <li>- Appliances and furniture</li> <li>- Automobile parts</li> <li>- Rinsed pesticide containers</li> <li>- Small animal carcasses</li> <li>- Household medical wastes</li> <li>- Household hazardous waste (includes oil, batteries, etc.)</li> <li>- Treated Infectious wastes</li> <li>- Medical wastes</li> <li>- Waste tires</li> </ul>
<b>C/D Debris</b>	<b>Construction / Demolition</b> - Construction industry - Demolition companies	Uncontaminated solid waste resulting from the construction, remodeling, repair, or demolition of structures. For example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Scrap lumber, wallboard</li> <li>- Roofing materials</li> <li>- Plumbing and electrical fixtures</li> <li>- Bricks, concrete, glass</li> <li>- Non-asbestos insulation</li> </ul>
<b>Foundry</b>	<b>Foundry Waste</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Waste sand, slag, sludge, core waste, dust fines, etc.</li> </ul>
<b>Coal Ash</b>	<b>Coal ash</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Coal ash</li> <li>- Fly ash, bottom ash, etc.</li> <li>- Ash resulting from the combustion of coal</li> </ul>
<b>FGD Waste</b>	<b>Flue gas desulfurization byproducts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Scrubber / FGD sludge</li> <li>- Pollution control sludges resulting from coal combustion</li> </ul>
<b>Other</b>	<b>Other</b> Any other non-municipal solid waste not classified as C/D, Foundry, Coal Ash, or FGD Waste.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Manufacturing process wastes (resins, oxides, etc.)</li> <li>- Asbestos-containing wastes</li> <li>- Pollution control waste</li> <li>- Oil/ gas/ mining wastes</li> <li>- Incinerator residues</li> <li>- Low-level PCB wastes</li> <li>- Contaminated Soils</li> </ul>
<b>Reuse for landfills only</b>	<b>Reuse</b> Waste material utilized for construction purposes in a landfill.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Alternate Daily Cover</li> <li>- Road Construction</li> <li>- Leachate Collection System Construction</li> <li>- Landscaping Mulch</li> </ul>
