State Mileage Reimbursement Rate

Due to the volatility of fuel prices the Department of Administration and the State Budget Agency have decided to change the frequency with which we review prices. We will now review prices every 3 months instead of every 6 months. In addition, our review period will only be the past 3 months as opposed to reviewing the past 6 months.

The sliding scale chart and reimbursement rates will remain the same, as seen below.

Average Fuel Cost	Reimbursement Per Mile
\$1.50 to \$1.76	35 cents per mile
\$1.77 to \$2.01	36 cents per mile
\$2.02 to \$2.27	37 cents per mile
\$2.28 to \$2.53	38 cents per mile
\$2.54 to \$2.79	39 cents per mile
\$2.80 to \$3.05	40 cents per mile
\$3.06 to \$3.31	41 cents per mile
\$3.32 to \$3.57	42 cents per mile
\$3.58 to \$3.83	43 cents per mile
\$3.84 to \$4.09	44 cents per mile
\$4.10 to \$4.35	45 cents per mile
\$4.36 to \$4.61	46 cents per mile
\$4.62 to \$4.87	47 cents per mile
\$4.88 to \$5.13	48 cents per mile

Based on the average fuel pricing evaluation of January, February, and March, the personal vehicle mileage reimbursement rate will change to \$0.42 per mile. This rate will be effective April 18, 2022.
