ADOPTION RESOLUTION FY 2013-01

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY2012-2015 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO UPDATE THE PROJECT COSTS AND SCHEDULES FOR CITY OF BLOOMINGTON & BLOOMINGTON TRANSIT PROJECTS as approved by the Policy Committee Chair and Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMCMPPO) Director on August 15, 2012.

WHEREAS, the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMCMPPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of Indiana as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for carrying out, with the State of Indiana, the provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134, and capable of meeting the requirements thereof for the Bloomington, Indiana urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bloomington and Bloomington Transit have identified the need to update the project costs and schedules for four projects and have requested that the BMCMPPO amend these projects in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments meet the requirements of the Public Participation Plan to be administratively approved by the Policy Committee Chair and the BMCMPPO Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- (1) The Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby amends the FY2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program as follows:
 - DES# 0600496, S. Rogers Street Reconstruction: Add DES# 1297261 to project listing, shift CON phase to FY 2013, add \$617,000 Local funds to the CON phase;
 - DES# 0902258, University Courts Brick Street Restoration: Shift CON phase to FY 2013, add PE phase in 2013 with \$52,300 Local funds;
 - DES# 1006383, Upgrade Signs (Zone 1): Shift CON phase to FY 2013; and
 - DES# 1297175, Bike Lockers: Shift CON phase to FY 2012, adjust project funding to reflect \$24,000 FTA 5309 and \$6,000 Local funds.

- (2) This resolution shall be forwarded to all relevant public officials and government agencies, and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours at the City of Bloomington Planning Department, located in the Showers Center City Hall at 401 North Morton Street, Bloomington, Indiana.
