Re: FY 2008-2011 STIP Transit Amendments #41, #42, #43, #44, #45, and #46

Dear Mr. Buckel:

This letter responds to your six (6) letters, dated October 28 (2), November 5 (3), and November 9 (1), 2009, requesting to amend the FY 2008 - 2011 Indiana Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The amendments incorporate programming revisions made to the Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission's FY 2009 -2013 Transportation Improvement Program, Michiana Area Council of Governments' FY 2008 - 2012 Transportation Improvement Program, the Area Plan Commission of Tippecanoe County's FY 2009 - 2013 Transportation Improvement Program, the Madison County Council of Governments' 2008 - 2011 Transportation Improvement Program, and the Kokomo - Howard County Governmental Coordinating Council's SFY 2008 - 2011 Transportation Improvement Program. The attached tables include only the FY 2010 projects that have been submitted to the FTA for approval. (Note: Administrative Modifications do not require FTA approval.) Projects in program years beyond FY 2010, that remain as viable projects, will be included in the approved and published TIPs and STIPs for the subsequent fiscal years.

We have determined that all of the FY 2010 transit projects included in these STIP amendments are financially constrained, and that the projects are consistent with the MPOs' and the State's Transportation Plans. We also find that the above TIPs are the result of Metropolitan Transportation Planning processes that substantially comply with the requirements of 23 CFR 450. In accordance with 23 CFR 450.220, we approve these STIP amendments.
